YOUR OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT (1982) REQUEST HBDHB REF: 0IA2022033

I refer to your Official Information Act request dated 22 February 2022 where you requested information from Hawke's Bay District Health Board (HBDHB). Your questions and HBDHB's response is provided below:

"Please indicate what is your exact procedure for determining that hospital admissions in this current time are in fact directly due to covid.

Ie: are u testing people who are admitting themselves for something non respiratory related and if they test positive after admission for sars cov 2 are you listing it as a covid admission regardless
Ie: people who are admitted for something respiratory related that is later diagnosed as not sars cov 2, are you indicating them as covid hospitalizations if they return a positive test during admission."

Hawke's Bay DHB tests all hospital admissions for COVID-19. Those who test positive for COVID-19 are then admitted to a dedicated COVID ward. Inpatients with COVID (whether arriving with COVID or testing positive once in our care) are included in COVID-related hospilisation statistics released by the Ministry of Health. This includes any COVID-related deaths.

Routine surveillance testing of hospital inpatients was introduced in early March 2022 to detect asymptomatic cases. You can see the full media release here: http://www.ourhealthhb.nz/news-and-events/latest-news/hawkes-bay-hospital-mobilises-dedicated-covid-ward-as-cases-rise/
