YOUR OFFICIAL INFORMATION ACT (1982) REQUEST HBDHB REF: 0IA2022046

I refer to your Official Information Act request dated 28 April 2022 where you requested information from Hawke's Bay District Health Board (HBDHB). Your questions and HBDHB's response is provided below:

- Details (including cost) of all overseas trips or delegations in the past 4 years that have been funded (including partial funding) by the Hawkes Bay District Health Board or any organisation that receives funding by the DHB.
- Details of any and all overseas trips/delegations that are planned for the future.

HBDHB incurred \$65,000 for international travel over the past four year period. The bulk of this amount (\$64K) covered travel by an intensivist presenting courses to medical professionals in a number of overseas locations, for which the DHB also received funding by the course provider.

The remaining amount was for attendance by two allied health staff to a medical conference in Australia.

The DHB did not fund foreign travel for any organisations that receives funding by the DHB (ending 31 March 2022).

Please note: That response does not include travel by Senior Medical Officers (SMOs) who are entitled to continuing medical education and sabbatical leave by their MECA agreement.

HBDHB has no overseas trips/delegations planned for the immediate future that is outside of continuing medical education.
